From the Public Works Team

In the last part of 2015, Jacksonville upgraded its water billing software to be fully integrated with the City's financial software system. Along with that computer software upgrade came the need to upgrade the water meter reading equipment, which in turn required the need to replace older meters to be fully compatible with the new system. We are now in the process of replacing meters throughout our water system with water meters that can be read by a Bluetooth connection.

The meter reads can be automatically downloaded into a handheld unit, which in turn automatically downloads into the billing system software. This is quite an improvement over the days when two men had to pull all the meter lids, write down the read in a book, and give the book to the office to manually enter the reads into a billing system machine.

There will not be scheduled times for the meter replacements due to unforeseen events that come up during the work day that interrupt any schedule. Water disruption should only be a few minutes and we will knock on the door before we start. The new meters will fit into the same space as the old meters so we won't be altering your plumbing on your side of the meter.
