Citizen Advisory Committee: Chapter One of the Jacksonville Comprehensive Plan

The City of Jacksonville is currently recruiting volunteers to serve on a Citizen Advisory Committee to review Chapter One of the Comprehensive Plan, *Citizen Involvement*. Applications are available on the City's website or City Hall. The deadline for applications is July 16 at 4:00 P.M.

The Police Protection Surcharge of \$20 per month will be effective July 1, 2018 and will not increase for five years.

A Surcharge Relief Program was approved by City Council on June 5, 2018 to be implemented with the effective date of the surcharge of July 1, 2018. If you have qualified for the Fire Protection Surcharge Relief, you will not need to apply for the Police Protection Surcharge Relief for the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year

Income:

\$30,001 or more \$20.00 per month

\$25,001 – 30,000 \$10.00 per month

\$25,000 or less \$ 0.00 per month

Applications for both the Fire Protection Surcharge Discount and the Police Protection Surcharge are on the website or can be obtained at City Hall or the Police Department. Applications need to be submitted to Kathy Tiller at the Police Department with the required documentation.

FIREWORKS SAFETY ON JULY 4TH

Summer is synonymous with barbecues, parades and fireworks displays. But along with all the festivities are plenty of visits to emergency rooms – especially during July.

In 2017, at least 11,100 were injured badly enough to require medical treatment after fireworks-related incidents, according to the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission. And while the majority of these incidents were due to amateurs attempting to use professional-grade, homemade or other illegal fireworks or explosives, thousands were from less powerful devices like small firecrackers and sparklers.

More fires are reported on July 4 than any other day of the year. On a typical Fourth of July, fireworks account for two out of five of all reported fires, according to the National Fire Protection Association. Each year, fireworks cause on average 1,300 structure fires, 300 vehicle fires and nearly 17,000 other fires resulting in thousands of injuries.

The National Safety Council advises everyone to stay away from all consumer fireworks and to only enjoy fireworks at a public display conducted by professionals.



Reminder:

No fireworks are allowed to be set off within the Jacksonville city limits.
