Code Revision Update:

Ian Foster, Planning Director gave the CCI an extensive update on the work that the CAC has accomplished thus far. The CAC is working on Chapter 2 covering Permitted Uses. We are updating tables as we work and will eventually present a draft of work that is done. We now have a new website for the public to stay abreast on any progress we make with the code update. We navigated through the website with the CCI to assure that people will be informed and to also help keep the community engaged in these certain times that we’re in. We will also keep people in the loop with articles in the Review magazine, written by different members of the CCI.

Tom Pratum The Draft Code was not ready, so we’re happy that it was not adopted. The CAC will work through this document slowly and smart, and taking our time is important. Tom also volunteered to write articles in the Review to keep the residence informed.

We discussed the Measure 57 Notice that goes out to every homeowner in Jacksonville


Community Outreach: We will schedule a Townhall either on Zoom or in-person. We need people aware of the Code update now, rather than later. The CCI should be spreading the news, via word of mouth that the Code is in the process of being updated by the CAC. Is there a way to see who is visiting our website? Is there a way to gather the names of who is visiting to get them further engaged?

Measuring Progress: All of the CAC meetings are recorded, and the public is encouraged to join via Zoom if they are curious, we would also encourage the CCI to join these meetings too to help spread the word on the progress the CAC is making. We need an adopted Code. We discussed many ways the CCI can help to engage the community. Ian handed out the CCI'S role and we discussed it.

We do have an opening on the CCI if you know of anyone, but we are not required to fill it because we have enough members at this time. Please share this roll with others to help us fill the space.

City Council Liaison Update: The City Council is working on updating portions of our Municipal Code and for this process the City Council does not rely on public input. They will soon be conducting study sessions on the Urban Growth Boundary. Both the Fire and Police Departments are hiring. The Council is also looking to fill a seat on the Budget Committee.
