Those Snowy Days in Jacksonville

This time of year, we occasionally get some snow or ice in the area and on the roads around Jacksonville. When this happens the Jacksonville Public Works Department can be found either plowing the roads, placing sand for traction or a combination of the two. We do have a priority in mind when we are out working the roads during a winter storm. Priorities are:

- Arterial/Collector roads: California, Oregon, N 5th St, S 3rd St, Applegate, etc.
- School areas and bus routes – if school is operating
- Hilly/Steep residential streets – Stage Coach, Wells Fargo, Coachman area, MaryAnn/Pair A Dice area, etc.
- Other residential streets around town

Public Works does not plow or sand alleys, private streets, driveways or streets where it is not feasible for our equipment to get in and get turned around.

City Council Meetings At-A-Glance

A synopsis of the previous month’s City Council agenda items and discussions so you, the citizens of Jacksonville, know what is going on in your local government. **If you would like more detail on any of the discussion items, please review the summaries for each item in the Council packet on the City website.**

January 5, 2021—City Council

- Mayor Bowen and Councilors McClain, Casaleggio and Thompson were sworn in to their positions.
- **Appoint Vacant City Council Position.** With the election of Councilor Bowen as Mayor, there was a vacant City Council position effective January 1, 2021. Staff posted for the upcoming position on December 2, 2020. The City received Applications for Appointment to City Council from Scott Selbe and Brad Bennington. Council heard from each of the applicants and appointed Scott Selbe to the vacant City Council position. Scott Selbe was sworn in as City Councilor.
- **Fire Department Annual Report.** Fire Chief Wayne Painter presented the Fire Department 2020 Annual Report to Council.
- **Approve Fire Fighter Hiring List.** With the current hiring list expiring, a Fire Fighter Assessment was conducted in December 2020. The exam process followed the State of Oregon Civil Service hiring requirements under ORS 242. Council approved the hiring list of seven candidates, which will expire June 30, 2022.
- **Elect Council President.** At the first meeting of each year the Council shall elect a Council president from its membership. Council elected Jim Lewis as Council President.
- **Appointment by Mayor of Council Members as Liaisons to Commissions and Committees.** In accordance with the provisions of the Jacksonville Municipal Code Sec. 2.36.220, the Mayor shall designate Council members to serve as liaison between the commissions and committees and the City Council. Mayor Bowen designated the liaisons as follows:

- **Appoint Planning Commissioner.** Council appointed Michael Schwartz to the Planning Commission with a four-year term of January 2021—December 2024.

- **Elect Urban Renewal Agency President.** Jim Lewis was elected as Urban Renewal Agency President.
- **Elect Urban Renewal Agency Vice President.** Steve Casaleggio was elected as Urban Renewal Agency Vice President.
