#### Program Overview:

At Jacksonville Fire, we are committed to enhancing the safety and well-being of our community. As part of our Smoke Alarm Replacement Program, we are offering a free smoke detector replacement service to residents within our community.

#### Program Objectives:

- Increase Awareness:** Educate residents about the importance of functioning smoke detectors in preventing fire-related injuries and fatalities.
- Ensure Compliance:** Replace outdated or non-functional smoke detectors to ensure that every home is equipped with reliable fire detection technology.
- Community Engagement:** Foster a sense of community safety and responsibility through proactive outreach and support.

#### Eligibility Criteria:

To qualify for the free smoke detector replacement service, residents must meet the following criteria:

- Reside within the City of Jacksonville.
- Have outdated or malfunctioning smoke detectors.

- Replacement:** Upon verification, our trained technicians will replace outdated or non-functional smoke detectors with modern, reliable models at no cost to the resident.

#### **January 2, 2024—City Council Meeting**

- **Resolution No. R2024-001—A Resolution Approving and Authorizing Amendment to the Solid Waste Collection Franchise Agreement Between the City of Jacksonville and Rogue Disposal and Recycling.** Resolution No. R2024-001 was approved amending the Solid Waste Collection Franchise Agreement to adjust the terms for the provision of audited financials statements for Rogue Disposal and Recycling.
- **Approval for Little Library—Right of Way.** Council approved the placement of a little free library on the corner of Westmont and MaryAnn Drive.
- **PUBLIC HEARING: Revision of Land Use Fees.** Council held a public hearing to review proposed land use fee revisions as presented by Planning Director Foster.
- **Resolution No. R2024-002—A Resolution Adjusting Certain Planning Department Fees.** Resolution No. R2024-002 was approved, adjusting planning department fees.
- **Approval of 2024 Organizational Chart.** Council approved the 2024 Organizational Chart as is required by JMC 2.01.080(c)
- **Elect Council President.** Councilor McClain was elected Council President for 2024.
- **Appointment by Mayor of Council Members as Liaisons to Commissions and Committees.** Mayor Bowen appointed Councilors as liaisons to the following commissions and committees: **Cemetery Commission:** Councilor McClain, **Committee for Citizen Involvement:** Councilor Thompson, **HARC:** Councilor Hellenthal, **OSHA:** Councilor Casaleggio, **Parks and Visitors Services:** Councilor Reed, **Planning Commission:** Councilor Casaleggio, **Transient Lodging Tax Committee:** Councilor Gregg, **RVCOG:** Councilor Thompson, **RVACT/MPO:** Mayor Bowen, **ECSO:** Fire Chief Painter.

- **Second Reading and Adoption of Ordinance No. O2023-006—An Ordinance Repealing Ordinance Nos. 185 and 482 and Current Title 7 of the Jacksonville Municipal Code and Replacing it with a New Title 7 as Herein Prescribed, Repealing Title 4, Section 4.02.030 of the Jacksonville Municipal Code, and Amending Title 4, Section 4.03.060 of the Jacksonville Municipal Code.** Council approved the second reading and adoption of Ordinance No. O2023-006.

#### **January 2, 2024—Urban Renewal Agency Meeting**

- **Elect Urban Renewal Agency President.** Director Casaleggio was elected Agency President for 2024.
- **Elect Urban Renewal Agency Vice President.** Director Thompson was elected Agency Vice President for 2024.

#### **January 16, 2023—Work Session**

- **Presentation of FY 2022-2023 Audit.** Auditors from KDP Certified Public Accountants, LLP presented the audit for FY 2022-2023 to Council and Budget Committee members in attendance.
