Emergency Alerting System

Get notified about emergencies and other community alerts via your home phone, cell phone, text message or email by signing up for the Jackson County Citizen Alert Program. Jackson County notification system helps local officials provide the citizens with critical information about emergencies within your community.

In the event of an emergency, local officials will use the Citizens alert system to notify citizens via landline, cell, or text messages. You have the option to choose which method works best for you.

Another option available to you is that you have the choice of choosing multiple locations to be notified about, whether it your house, or a friend's house in another city, you can receive notifications if an incident occurs in either one of those locations.

City Council Meeting Agenda Items

December 4, 2018

- **Canvass the Vote and Accompanying Proclamation.** Council approved the abstract of the votes for the November 6, 2018 General Election. Jacksonville has 2549 registered voters with 2114 ballots cast, which was an overall turnout of 82.93%.

City Councilors serving a four year term beginning January 1, 2019 are James Lewis, Kenneth Gregg and Donna Bowen. Measure 15-180—Jacksonville Food and Beverage Tax was voted down, 66.22% to 33.78%.

- **Council Round Table Discussion 2018 and 2019.** During a round table discussion each Council Member reflected on 2018 and the needs of the City for 2019.
- **Recognition for Service—Councilor Brad Bennington.** The Mayor, Council and City Administration recognized outgoing Councilor Brad Bennington for his years of service.
