City-wide yard sale policy for September 8-10, 2023

1. Allow sales for all participants on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, September 8-10, 2023
2. Require a vendor business license, which costs \$10 per day (purchase at City offices) for all parties **other than** Jacksonville residents selling their possessions from their own property.
3. Permit issued by city staff to be displayed on each vendor booth at the time of the yard sale. Permits can be purchased **NO LATER than September 6th at 3:00 p.m. NO EXCEPTIONS.** Please allow time to mail the permit unless you are buying in person. (Cash or checks only- PO Box 7, Jacksonville OR 97530 – 206 N 5th St. Blding A.)
4. No sales or displays can be set in the public right-of-way.
5. Set-up is allowed Thursday, September 7th, by 6 p.m. and ending by 10 p.m. (NO SALES ALLOWED during set-up).
6. Sales are allowed at 7 a.m. each day of the three-day event and ending by 8 p.m.
7. No sales from any vehicle parked in the public right-of-way are allowed.
8. Non-profit organizations will be issued a permit at no charge (status is verified on the Secretary of State website).
9. No permit will be needed for homeowners who sell from their property within the city limits.
10. If a homeowner sells from a commercial, public use (ie, Church, authorized parking lot, etc.) or non-residential property, the homeowner will be considered a vendor and will be charged the permit fee of \$10 per day and will be subject to the posting of the permit requirements.
11. If an entity sells with a current Jacksonville business license, a permit will be issued at no charge.
12. There will be a greater effort by City staff to cordon off N 5th St. as it is a State Highway, and no parking is allowed. Parking will be addressed by Public Works on E California St. to the east of N. 5th.
13. **Parking citations will be issued for those illegally parked.** All food vendors must meet the requirements set forth by Jackson County and obtain a business license.

Safety is the top concern for this event. Please help keep the streets clear for emergency vehicles to pass through. Remind people to be cautious of the extra traffic and the dangers of crossing the crowded streets. Remind people they cannot leave vehicles in the traffic lane 'even for a moment'. -- Have a successful sale weekend!
